# International Student Application Instructions for Admission (for F-1 Students)

## APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications are recommended to be received by:

- August Admission - June 1
- January Admission - November 15

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Cost of Attendance.** Updated each year and includes tuition, fees, living expenses, books, and health insurance. See [International Admissions website](#) for most up-to-date cost estimates.
- **On-Campus Housing is Available.** Early application for on-campus housing is recommended due to high demand. You may apply for housing **after** receiving official acceptance to the college.
- **Calendar.** Fall semester begins in late August; spring semester begins in late January of each academic year.

## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION ■ ■ ■

1. If you are applying for admission to multiple colleges/universities in the State University of New York (SUNY) system, you can fill out and submit the [SUNY application](#). There is a \$50 application fee for the SUNY application. You will be prompted to select Monroe Community College within the SUNY application from a list of campuses. **If you are applying only to Monroe Community College, please fill out and submit the [MCC application](#). There is no application fee.**
2. **SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:** You must send the following documents directly to the college's Admission Office after submitting the online application:
  - HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS**  
Submit official high school transcripts (marks sheets, exam results, certificates). We will accept photocopied transcripts with an original signature or certification from a school official. Transcripts must be in English and include evidence of graduation or completion date.
  - COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS (IF APPLICABLE)**  
Submit official transcripts of all post-secondary coursework. If you wish to transfer foreign university credit to MCC, you must use a credential evaluation service such as World Education Services, [www.wes.org](http://www.wes.org). (Course-by-course evaluation needed)
  - EVIDENCE OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY**  
Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), International English Language Testing System (IELTS), or Duolingo English Test must be taken if English is not your first language. MCC requires a minimum score of 55 on internet-based TOEFL, 5.5 band score on IELTS, or 80 on Duolingo to be considered for admission. Additionally, students have the opportunity to take one of our campus placement tests (CELSA or Accuplacer ESL) as an option to prove English language proficiency for the purpose of admission and English course placement at MCC.
  - FINANCIAL DOCUMENTATION: REQUIRED FOR I-20 AND F-1 VISA ISSUANCE**
    1. **Submit official bank statements** showing availability of sufficient funds to pay for at least one year of study. The statements must be official, in English, and currently dated (no statements older than 2 months).
    2. **Download, complete, and submit the:** [SUNY International Student Financial Statement](#)
  - PHOTO IDENTIFICATION**  
Provide a copy of your **passport ID page**. If you have an existing F-1 visa, provide a copy
  - PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION**  
After receiving official acceptance to the college, you must provide [documentation of immunization](#) against measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR). As a member of SUNY (State University of New York), MCC adheres to the COVID-19 vaccination mandate set by State government.
  - HEALTH INSURANCE**  
All F-1 students are required to have health and accident insurance and are automatically enrolled in the college's health insurance plan.
