Additional areas of responsibility include; recruitment and hiring, accreditation, training initiatives for both sworn and non-sworn academies as well as in-service training for current staff, fleet operations, quartermaster, executive services detail (support for trustee, VIP, dignitary visits), internal and external communications, including social media and PIO efforts. Responsible for all matters related to Clery compliance.

Captain, *University of Rochester Department of Public Safety* - Responsible for programming and maintenance of central station alarm monitoring (MAstermind), CCTV applications and University wide access control program (including ID Badge production). These systems combine over 13,000 security and fire alarm points, 300 cameras and 1300 card readers. Advisor to construction projects with emphasis on access control, alarms, CCTV and lighting during the design and building phases of projects University wide as well as working with the city and county on projects that affect the University community.

Lieutenant, *University of Rochester Department of Public Safety* - Responsible for technical support to all aspects of the Department of Public Safety, these duties include the operation of a central station that monitors University fire and security alarms as well as receiving over 300,000 calls per year. Development of a University wide CCTV program and coordination of the emergency phone network. Manage and allocate budgetary resources for crime prevention programs, conduct cost analysis of new programs and initiation of new projects. Conduct investigations of crimes occurred and track statistical data in the UCR format. Conduct background investigations on prospective employees.

Sergeant, *University of Rochester Department of Public Safety* - Responsible for creation and implementation of crime prevention, personal safety and community awareness programs for faculty, staff and students.

Research and Training Specialist, *Office of the Attorney General, Tallahassee, Florida*. Responsible for education, information services and technical assistance associated with the Florida Safe Neighborhoods Program: Working with local governments in their tasks involved with Safe Neighborhoods, training, and technical assistance, on-and off-site consultation, computer aided design work, data collection, analysis and review of neighborhood improvement plans. Also worked with communities in meeting requirements for grant funds that they were receiving.
