

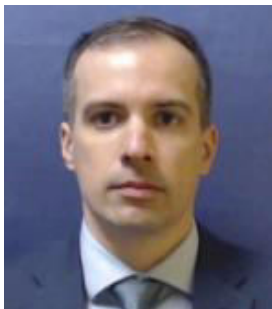


### THREE THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT ME ...
