Grading Updates

- S/P/U Grades:
 - S = C for quality point calculation
 - P = D- for quality point calculation
- Unsuccessful Attempts:
 - Grades of C- or below and withdraws from **Spring/Summer/Fall 2020** will NOT count against a student's eligibility to apply
 - Transfer institutions may **ONLY** exclude Spring 2020
- Reminder: unsuccessful Anatomy & Physiology attempts at previous institutions within the past seven years are considered in the selection process (with the exception of 2020) and students may not be eligible. (Applies to Dental Hygiene, Nursing, Rad Tech, and Surgical Tech.)

Nursing Admission Criteria

- Reminder: 2.75 cumulative GPA required, including all credit bearing coursework at previous colleges.
- TEAS test is on hold until further notice.



DENTAL HYGIENE



Changes to the Dental Studies Admission Criteria

Dental Assisting:

- Points no longer awarded for currently enrolled students seeking admission into Hygiene. Rather...

Dental Hygiene:

- 2.75 Cumulative GPA required
- 1 point for bachelor's degree
- 2 points for master's degree
- 1 point for DA01/DA03 graduates (already graduated)
- 1 point for NYS licensed RDAs
- 2 points for notarized proof of employment letter from Dentist (1000 hours worked as an RDA)
- Reminder: Math requirement in the program has been removed; High School Algebra or MTH 098 prerequisite remains



RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY



Radiologic Technology Admission Criteria and Curriculum Reminders

- 2.75 cumulative GPA required, including all credit bearing coursework at previous colleges
- Advisement note – pending curriculum changes, please consider the following courses:
 - Humanities requirements – ENG 101/200 and SPC 141
 - Social Science requirements – HEG 215 (PSY 101 will be removed)
 - Math requirements – MTH 165 or higher; do not take MTH 160
 - Science requirements – BIO 144 and 145 (only BIO 144 is included in quality points)
 - Reminder: BIO 142 and PHY 141 are no longer offered, yet are currently listed in the program outline
- Points are only be based on three classes: ENG 101 or 200, BIO 144, MTH 165 or higher. PSY 101 is no longer included in the quality point tally, since it will most likely be removed from the program.

 - Non-credit coursework is not included
 - Excluded coursework is not included (repeated or Fresh Start)
 - AP/IB/CLEP is not included, but dual credit is
