Ms. Scott reported on the Board of Trustees' recommended site for the new downtown campus.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution of Support

Whereas, on December 10, 2011, the Monroe Community College's Board of Trustees unanimously passed a resolution of recommendation concerning the relocation of Monroe Community College's downtown campus; and,

Whereas, the Monroe Community College Board of Trustees recommended that Monroe Community College's downtown campus should be moved from its current location on Main Street, to properties at State Street and Morrie Silver Way currently owned by Eastman Kodak Company; and,

Whereas, the Monroe Community College Board of Trustees' action marks the culmination of a deliberative search process focused on balancing the needs and interests of students, taxpayers, and local employers that rely on and benefit from the college; and,

Whereas, many DCC students have personal safety concerns in and around the Sibley Building; and,

Whereas, Monroe Community College is faced with an increased demand for an expanded facility that provides better parking and safety features than those offered at the Sibley Building; and,

Whereas, the Kodak property has the greatest potential to become a learning environment where students can succeed; and,

Whereas, the mission of Monroe Community College is to provide access to high-quality education and training programs to a diverse community; and,

Whereas, the recommended site for the new downtown campus will enable Monroe Community College to fulfill its mission,

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Damon City Campus Student Events and Governance Association firmly believes that the recommended site of Monroe Community College's new downtown campus is in the best interests of the students; and,

Be it further resolved, that the Damon City Campus Student Events and Governance Association hereby officially supports the recommendation made by the Monroe Community College Board of Trustees; and,

Finally, be it resolved, that the Damon City Campus Student Events and Governance Association hereby officially endorses the MCC Board of Trustees' efforts made in good faith on behalf of all students here at Monroe Community College.

The resolution was moved by Ms. Ginevra, seconded by Mr. Muhammad, and unanimously approved.
