Workshop Checklist

First steps Bring the following documents if applicable:

- Student's 2011 Federal Tax Return
- If you are a dependent student, Parents' 2011 Federal Tax Return.
- Student's 2011 New York State Tax Return
- Parents' 2011 New York State Tax Return if you are under 22 years of age.
- You need to know the total amount of untaxed income received in 2011. If you, your spouse, or your parents (if applicable) received any untaxed income during 2011, such as child support you need report it in the financial aid application.
