Resolution to Approve the Allocation of Funds to the Engineering Leadership Council

Whereas the Contingency funding process has been adopted by the Student Government Association for this year.

Whereas the Engineering Leadership Council have requested funds for and educational international competition in Patuxent River Maryland.

Whereas as the competition is for Unmanned Aircraft Systems.

Whereas Engineering Leadership Council have done different fundraisers such as the Egg drop, Bridge building, and constant sales of snacks and drinks

Whereas the total cost of the trip is \$9001.00 which includes lodging, gas, tolls, taxi/subway/shuttle/miscellaneous, and registration fees.

Whereas the ELC will be contributing \$7,334.45 towards the trip.

Whereas the participants will be paying \$20 out of pocket

Whereas the Unmanned Aircraft Systems is a sub group of the Engineering Leadership Council.

Whereas Monroe Community College will be the only community college participating in this international competition, as well as other Ivy League schools this gives our students a chance to put MCC on the map.

Whereas this competition will have representation from industry and government organizations during the event, such as Google Inc, Garmin, Boeing and many more. This will allow our students valuable exposure to top organizations with possible internship and professional development. In front of top universities and industry leaders, our team will be representing MCC's mission and vision.

Whereas the Engineering Leadership Council is trying to save money on this trip they all will be camping for the weekend.

Whereas last year this sub group of the Engineering Leadership Council hosted the first annual unmanned aerial vehicle design competition and plan to be hosting it again this year. They have invited local community colleges, and the local community to participate in this event.

Resolution to approve the Allocation of Funds to the Campus Ambassadors

Whereas the Contingency funding process has been adopted by the Student Government Association for this year.

Whereas Campus Ambassadors have requested funds for a sound system. That include a PA system, speakers, microphones, and stands.

Whereas they have done different fundraisers such as Vendors and will be starting candy bar sales.

Whereas the total cost of the sound equipment will cost \$1,349.95

Whereas the Campus Ambassadors will be contributing \$300 towards purchasing the equipment.

Whereas the Campus Ambassadors have been using borrowed equipment from a family out in Brockport, and this is no longer a feasible thing to pick up and drop off multiple times a week.

Whereas the equipment is going to be used in programing and events to reach out to their large amount of members.
