Mr. Visagie introduced the following resolution:

Resolution to Support a Tuition Increase for the 2011-2012 Academic Year

Whereas, under the preamble of the Student Events and Governance Association, SEGA is charged with promoting the general welfare of the student body and providing a means through which the student body may voice its wishes on matters which directly concern it, and

Whereas, Student Trustee Eddie Visagie is seeking the advice and consent of the Student Events and Governance Association to speak on behalf of the student body, and

Whereas, Monroe Community College's overall operating budget will remain flat due to cuts in funding from New York State, and

Whereas, the Brighton Campus Student Government Association Presidential Cabinet approved this resolution on March 24, 2011, and

Whereas, the Brighton Campus Student Government Association Senate approved this resolution on March 29, 2011, be it

Resolved, that the Student Events and Governance Association support a tuition increase of up to \$50/semester for full-time students and an increase of up to \$4/credit hour for part-time students, and be it

Resolved, that these increases will double for out of state residents; \$100/semester or \$8/credit hour respectfully, and further be it

Resolved, these changes will be in effect for the 2011-2012 Academic Year upon approval from the Monroe Community College Board of Trustees.

A motion was made by Mr. Carey and seconded by Mr. Cherry to approve the resolution. Motion approved.
