


Financial Aid Applications Workshop Schedule and Policies

Applying for Aid

To apply for the 2014-2015 Financial Aid year (Summer 2014, Fall 2014 and Spring 2015):

- ☐ Student's 2013 Federal and New York State Tax Return
- ☐ If you are a dependent student,
 - Parents' 2013 Federal and New York State Tax Return if you are under 22 years of age.
 - Your parent/stepparent's date of birth, social security number and date of marital status.
- ☐ You need to know the total amount of untaxed income received in 2013. If you, your spouse, or your parents (if applicable) received any untaxed income during 2013, such as child support you need to report it on the financial aid application.
