TAKE COLLEGE CLASSES WHILE YOU'RE STILL IN HIGH SCHOOL!



There are many good reasons to take a class at Monroe Community College while you're still in high school:

- get a head start on college,
- complete required classes before entering college,
- learn more about a subject that interests you, but is not taught in high school,
- start investigating careers,
- complete high school graduation requirements while earning college credit (with the approval of your high school),
- get a chance to experience college life.

Participation in the Monroe Advantage Program will give you an edge when you enter college — you'll already have completed a college course, plus you'll have more confidence and an easier transition from high school to college.

EARN COLLEGE CREDIT

When you take a course through the Monroe Advantage Program, you'll receive the same academic credit as any MCC student. This credit can be counted toward a degree at Monroe Community College, and is transferable to other colleges and universities nationwide.

If you enroll in just one college course each semester and summer of your junior and senior years, you'll have accumulated an entire semester of college credit before graduating from high school!

CONVENIENT SCHEDULING

It's easy to fit an MCC class around your high school schedule. Classes are scheduled throughout the day and into the evening, on Saturdays and over the internet. Courses can meet once, twice, or three times a week (online courses have no specific meeting times).

The cost of an MCC course is based on the number of credit hours for which you enroll. For the 2006-2007 academic year, each credit is \$113, so a 3-credit hour course would be \$339.* The majority of MCC courses are 3 credit hours, some specialized courses are 4 credit hours.

SERVICES FOR MONROE ADVANTAGE STUDENTS

The Monroe Advantage Program offers a number of support services to its students, starting with individual counseling before enrollment and continuing during the semester. Students in the program can attend an orientation session before attending classes. Monroe Advantage students are also eligible to use College facilities, including the library, computer facilities, gym, pool, racquetball courts, etc.

TO APPLY

1. Complete the Monroe Advantage Program Application in this brochure. You must include the signatures of one parent or guardian and your high school counselor on the application.

2. Submit the completed application, along with a \$10 application fee and your high school transcript to:

Note: Past Monroe Advantage Program participants must submit a new application each semester but do not have to pay the \$10 fee. Monroe Advantage students who apply to MCC after high school graduation will have the regular application fee (\$20) waived.

CONVENIENT LOCATIONS

MCC classes are offered at the Brighton campus (1000 East Henrietta Road), the Damon City campus (downtown in the former Sibley Building), and at extension sites at high schools in Fairport, Greece, Fairport, Honeoye Falls, Spencerport, and Webster.

RTS buses stop at both MCC's main campus in Brighton and the Damon City campus. If you drive to the Brighton Campus, you'll need to purchase a student parking permit when you register for classes. Damon City campus students can park in the St. Joseph's Garage at a reduced rate (free on Saturday and in the evening).
