

MCC DISC GOLF COURSE RULES

1. Please respect the course and abide by a policy of carry in and carry out of your trash.
2. If you lose a disc in the water, please do not swim after the disc. There is no swimming in any of the natural ponds on the MCC Campus.
3. There is no alcohol allowed on the course. If you are an MCC student you will be brought up on disciplinary charges. All others would be asked by Public Safety to leave the course/campus.
4. Please respect the course as it is designed. Please do not damage trees, remove the tee markers, move the rocks that are used as markers in the woods or any other changes to the course. Leave the course in better shape than you found it.
5. Parking for the disc golf course is in the back of lot G (lot closest to the tennis courts). Leave a note on your dashboard that you are playing disc golf and you should not receive a ticket. Parking on the access road or in other lots could result in a ticket, multiple violations could result in your car being booted.
6. On the backside of the tennis courts is a practice basket (the 19th hole) where you can practice your variety of shots in a wide open area.
