Monroe Community College SUNY General Education Course Plan

This plan applies to students who intend to transfer and graduate from a SUNY college or university.

You should complete a minimum of one course in seven of the ten Knowledge and Skill areas. (**Exception:** Engineering Science requirement is five of the ten areas.)

If you are transferring courses from another college or university, they may fulfill SUNY General Education requirements. (See your advisor.)

Some requirements may be waived based upon high school work. If you qualify for a SUNY General Education waiver under the Regents Category (see below), contact the Admissions Office.

Using the grid on the back, circle courses completed and maintain this document as a record of requirements that have been fulfilled.

Courses meeting SUNY General Education requirements are identified in the catalog course description. Example: SUNY-M fulfills the Mathematics knowledge and skill area.

Completing courses in all 10 areas will assure optimal transfer.

The SUNY General Education Course Plan is **NOT** a requirement to graduate from MCC.
