

## ABOUT THE PLACEMENT TEST

The ESOL Placement Test is required for students whose primary language is not English. It is a multiple choice, computer-based test that requires recognition of an appropriate grammatical form and/or specific vocabulary item. This is a timed test of 45 minutes. The purpose is to evaluate knowledge of everyday English.

## REVIEW FOR THE PLACEMENT TEST

The best preparation for the ESOL placement test is using English everyday to challenge oneself in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Study of vocabulary and grammar in context may also be helpful. Useful media include books, newspapers, magazines, films, TV, and internet resources (see "Useful Links" on the ESOL department web page). Skill in typing is recommended.

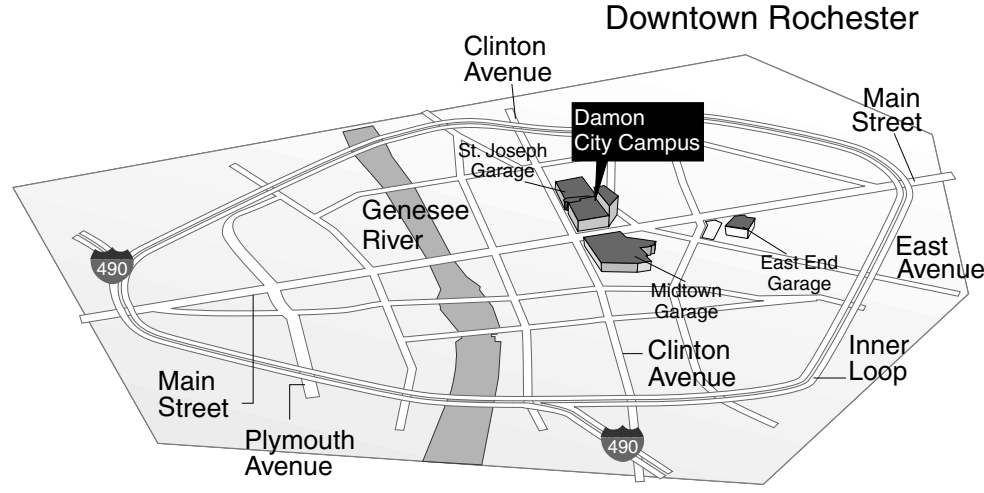

# PARKING INFORMATION

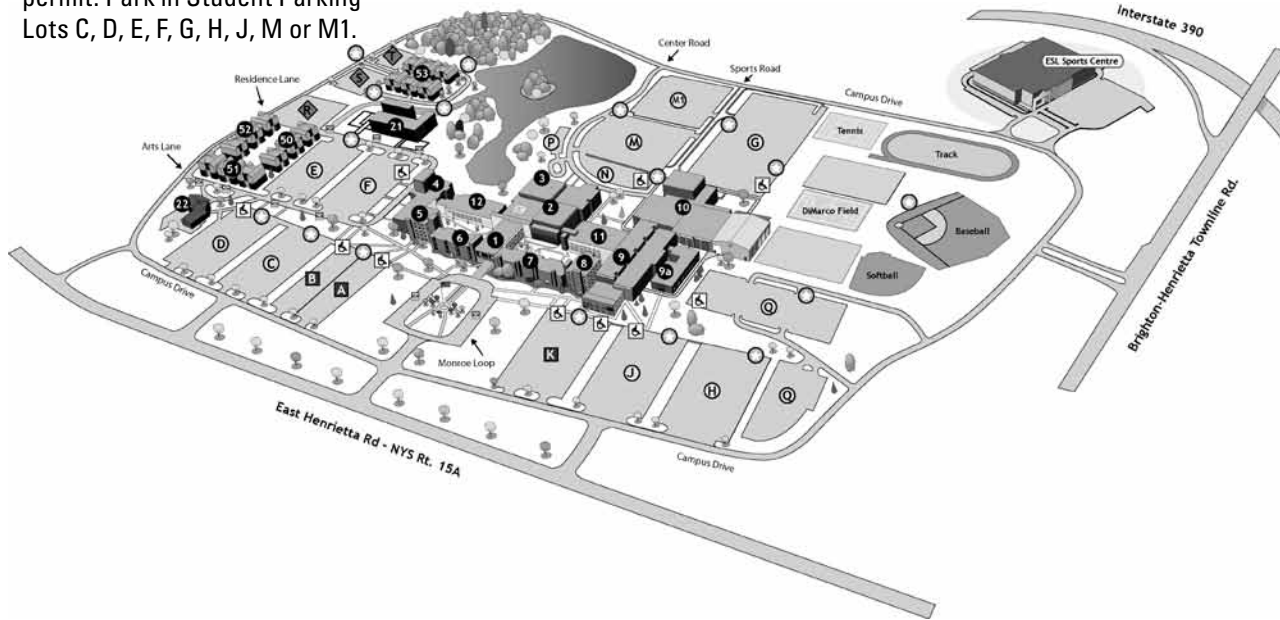
## DAMON CITY CAMPUS
