

Location:

The Dental Hygiene Clinic is located in Building 7, Room 201, at MCC's Brighton campus, 1000 East Henrietta Rd. A bus line serves the campus from downtown Rochester.

PARKING

From the main entrance on E. Henrietta Road, patients should turn right at the crossroads. Patient parking is available in Lot "K". At the entrance to the lot, press the speaker button and state you are a dental clinic patient. Proceed to the edge of the lot and park in the designated dental patient area. Patients must check in at the reception desk upon entering the clinic and pay \$1.00 parking fee at that time. Violators will be ticketed.

WELCOME

The Dental Hygiene Program of Monroe Community College welcomes you to the Clinic. The Clinic functions as an integral part of the Dental Hygiene Program, staffed by Registered Dental Hygienists with advanced educational degrees and a Supervising Dentist. The program seeks to create an educational climate which facilitates the development of professional dental hygienists. Everyone is welcome in our clinic. However, clients 17 and younger, **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian for the entire initial appointment.

CLIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The Dental Hygiene Clinic is an educational facility where students provide care with close supervision by clinical faculty. Frequent instructor interaction results in longer appointments. **The client should expect to arrive promptly at the scheduled time and remain up to 3 hours. Multiple appointments may be necessary in order to thoroughly treat the needs of the client.**

In order for students to progress in their clinical skills towards graduation, they are expected to fulfill specific requirements. This necessitates client cooperation and return visits until completion. Cancellations at the last minute make continuity of care difficult, if not impossible. If cancelling an appointment is necessary, please call the clinic at 292-2045 at least 24 hours prior to appointment. Continued cancellations may limit your opportunity for further appointments.

PATIENT BILL OF RIGHTS

Patients seeking dental health care at the Dental Hygiene Clinic have the right to:

- Health care that is accessible and that meets professional standards, regardless of the setting.
- Be treated with courtesy and respect.
- Information about their diagnosis, prognosis, and treatment.
- Informed participation in all decisions concerning their health care.
- Information about the qualifications, names and titles, of personnel responsible for providing their health care.
- Refuse observation by those not directly involved in their care.
- Privacy during interview, examination, and treatment.
- Privacy in communicating and visiting with persons of their choice.
- Refuse treatments, medications, or participation in research and experimentation, without punitive action being taken against them.
- Coordination and continuity of health care.
- Appropriate instruction or education from health care personnel so that they can achieve an optimal level of wellness and understanding of their basic health care needs.
- Confidentiality of all records
- Access to all health records pertaining to them
- Information on the charges for services, including the right to challenge them.
- Be fully informed as to all their rights in all health care settings.

- Radiographs (X-rays) - types of radiographs that may be necessary:
 - Complete survey - single films - Panoramic - Bite-wing (BWX) - Full mouth series
- Fluoride Treatment
- Sealants, if necessary
- Nutritional Counseling
- Diagnostic study models
- Intra-oral photographs, if necessary

The following services are not taught to Clinical competency and therefore are not offered:

- Placing and removing rubber dams,
- Selecting and pre-fitting provisional crowns,
- Selecting and pre-fitting orthodontic bands,
- Removing orthodontic arch wires and ligature ties,
- Placing and removing matrix bands,
- Removing periodontal dressings.
