SUNY Brockport	<p>Six credits of the same college level foreign language</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Only need 3 credits of Level 2 (102) foreign language if student completed 3 years in high school and received an 85 or higher on the Regents exam.</p> <p>Proficiency in a foreign language may also be determined by AP scores and results of the CLEP test</p>	YES	YES
SUNY Buffalo State	<p>BS degree –All students are required to complete a 102 level course or two years (units) of one foreign language in high school.</p> <p>Completion of one language through the second year in high school satisfies the requirement.</p> <p>If the student passes the high school Regents exam. Proficiency in foreign language also may be achieved by completing 6 credits on the CLEP test.</p>	YES	YES
SUNY Cortland	<p>Successfully complete the second semester (102) of a college level foreign language sequence OR</p> <p>Confirm proficiency equivalent to successful completion of the second semester (102) of a college –level foreign language sequence through a testing program approved by the SUNY Cortland International Communications and Culture Department</p>	<p>YES – But ONLY for the following EDU programs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Childhood Education, • Early Childhood Education, • Early Childhood/ Childhood Education, • Inclusive Special Education • Adolescence Education: Mathematics (7-12) • Adolescence Education: Physics (7-12) 	YES – for students pursuing a B.S. degree

SUNY Fredonia	Must complete 6 credits in the same college level foreign language OR Completed 3 years of high school foreign language with an 85% or higher on the regents exam	YES	YES
SUNY Geneseo	Intermediate level proficiency is required, equal to MCC's 103 level Foreign Language courses, OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four years of the same foreign language in High School with an 85% or higher on the regents exam. The fourth year must be AFTER the regents exam, OR • A score of 4 or better on the advanced placement examination in a foreign language, OR • Equivalent coursework with a minimum grade of C- transferred from another college 	YES	YES
Keuka College	One semester of foreign language OR 2 years of high school foreign language	YES	YES
Nazareth College	Six credits of the same college level foreign language EXCEPT Students in the Adol. Ed program with Business/Marketing as a concentration	NO <i>(Exception: Music Ed Art Ed Business Ed)</i>	NO If the student already took SPA 122, register for SPA 102 & NAZ will accept the SPA 122
Niagara University	3 credits of college level Foreign Language	YES	YES
SUNY Oswego	Successfully complete three 3 credits at the 102 level OR Four years of same foreign language in high school	YES	YES

Roberts Wesleyan College	<p>Proficiency in a foreign language may be shown by the following:</p> <p><u>Childhood and Adolescence Education Majors:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completing three years of the same language in high school with grades of C or better. Grades 7 & 8 each count as ½ year if the same language is continued at a higher level. • If no language was taken in high school, passing two sequential semesters of the same language at Roberts Wesleyan College. • Continuing at the appropriate level a language begun in high school until successful completion of the 102 level. • Successful performance on the final examination for the 102 level course in the language of choice. No course credit is given for passing the exam. • Successful performance on the CLEP examination to the six-credit level in the language of choice, or successful performance on a College-approved examination to the six-credit level for languages not offered in the CLEP. <p><u>Art Education & Music Education:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A minimum of 2 years of a foreign language with grades of C or better taken in high school or one semester at the appropriate level in college. 	<p>YES, for education majors, with the following EXCEPTION:</p> <p>ASL does not fulfill the foreign language requirement for Music Education-Vocal</p>	YES
St. John Fisher College	Six credits of the same college level Foreign Language	<p>YES with the following exception:</p> <p>Any student planning to transfer to SJFC in the Adolescence B.A. degree program with a concentration in English, History, or Math MUST choose a foreign language other than ASL.</p>	YES
