Ellen Mancuso started her career at MCC in 1989 when she was hired as a Circulation Librarian and continued in this title until 2009 when her title was changed to Liaison and Metrics Librarian and continued until she retired this summer. She served on the Faculty Association since 1998 and was Legislative Committee Chair when she retired. Ellen was an active member of Good Shepard Church in Henrietta and continues to volunteer her time to the Church.
