



### C. Student and Parent Tax Forms and Income From Work

All tax filers must submit a signed copy of all 2001 Federal Income Tax returns which include the 2001 IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, TeleFile Tax Record, a tax return from Puerto Rico or a foreign income tax return for those people checked below:
