Nursing A.A.S. (NUE1) Admission Information – High School Applicants

Deadline: Application deadline is January 31, 2012 for Fall 2012. Please note: All transcripts must be submitted by the January 31st date to be considered.

Notification: Admission notifications will be mailed March 1, 2012 for Fall 2012.

Prerequisites for Admission:

Prerequisite courses must be completed prior to the application deadline with a grade of “C” or higher.

- Algebra
- Biology/Life Science
- Chemistry
- US citizen or have Permanent Resident Status by the application deadline
- New York State resident residing in Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, or Wayne counties

Selection will be based on the grades received on the Regents exam for the courses listed above. Regents exams are weighted heavier than local level exams, but local level will be accepted. Each fall, 15-20 high school students are admitted into NUE1.

The NUE1 option is designed for those applicants coming into the nursing program directly from high school. Students enrolled in this option take three years to complete the program. Many credits required of the baccalaureate degree program can be completed while attending MCC.
