Enhanced Bomb Threat Management Seminar

Overview

The Homeland Security Management Institute (HSMI) of Monroe Community College is offering a seminar entitled “ Enhanced Bomb Threat Management Seminar.” This two and a half hour course is intended to teach key staff how to effectively prepare and implement a bomb threat plan for any educational institution, faith-based facility, local business or security agency.

Is your facility prepared to handle a bomb threat or recognize a suspicious device? Do you know what they look like or how they could be used. This seminar incorporates the latest examples of hazardous/suspicious devices, how to effectively deal with threats (received via telephone, internet, mail, or other means), and work with law enforcement including hazardous device squad (HDS) units and police robots.

Local experts in bomb detection, disposal and risk mitigation will discuss key elements of developing and implementing a successful and realistic plan to deal with this threat.
