Overview

The Homeland Security Management Institute (HSMI) of Monroe Community College is offering a two-hour free training course entitled "Citizen Preparedness Program".

Extreme events –droughts, wildfires, tornados, floods, heat waves, fierce storms and blizzards. Yet, the great majority of our citizens are not prepared to respond to natural disasters, man-made threats, or pandemic events.

Before an Event:

During an Event:

- Follow the advice and guidance of officials

After an Event:

- Have knowledge of disaster recovery measures
- Be alert for dangerous or hazardous conditions
