About HSMI:

About This Course/Target Audience:

The "Intro to Terrorism" course is designed to give students a general understanding of terrorism, terrorist activities, and basic survival skills in a hostage situation. This course is primarily designed for managers and employees in all types of organizations that need to prepare to respond to a disaster and restore normal operations afterward.

This course is a self-paced open entry/open exit course, meaning students can complete the course on their time without specific due dates or interaction with fellow students. However, an instructor monitors the course and requires students to complete the simple learning activities.

Topics Covered:

- Introduction to Terrorism and Terrorist Groups
- Individual Protective Measures
- Terrorist Operations
- Hostage Survival

Course Requirements:

There are no pre-requisite courses or required background.

Time Frame: This course opens on October 5, 2009. Students must complete this course by August 30, 2010.
