About This Course/Target Audience:

The "Basic Emergency Preparedness for Citizens" course is intended to provide information on how to keep you and your family healthy, safe and secure in the event of a disaster or other emergencies that disrupts the flow of necessary supplies and services. This course is designed for concerned citizens interested in learning about personal emergency preparedness.

This course is a self-paced, open entry/open exit course, meaning students can complete the course on their time without specific due dates or interaction with fellow students. However, an instructor monitors the course and requires students to complete simple online learning activities.

Topics Covered:

- Introduction to emergency preparedness
- Fire safety
- Emergency Supplies Kit
- Emergency first aid
- Sheltering in place
- Evacuation

Course Requirements: There are no pre-requisites or required background.

Time Frame: This course opens October 3, 2011, with 90 days to complete the course. Students may register for this course any time before May 28, 2012, and is open for approximately ninety (90) days once the student has started the session.

Fee: There is no cost to receive this training. A certificate will be awarded upon successful completion.
