Public Health Emergencies

Overview

This course is designed to increase knowledge and awareness of potential biological incidents and response to biological incidents relating to the perspectives of:

- Historical overview of biological incidents
- Action and response plan development
- Epidemiology and etiology on biological agents
- Public reaction and strategies to address public reaction to biological incidents
- Information technology systems and biological incidents
- Business continuity following a biological incident



Course Description

The course involves a careful examination of history of biological incidents, biological agents in natural and mediated events, behavioral and psychological reactions to impending or evolving bio-incidents, and communication systems used during bio-incident. The goal of this course is to provide participants with the knowledge and tools to develop action and response plans specific to their personal or organizational needs in response to a biological incident.

Time Frame and Requirements

This course can be instructed for either four hours or one hour. A minimum of 15 people required to schedule a training session.
