Monroe Community College is well known for its strong tradition of outstanding catchers. MCC Catchers have been selected to many post season honors, such as NJCAA All Region III, All Northeast District and JUCO All-American teams. The nominations were given not only for their offense, but because of the outstanding defense that the MCC receivers displayed. This has been proven by the many scholarships granted to the MCC catchers from outstanding 4 year baseball institutions as well as opportunities presented by Major League Baseball. Some of these institutions include Florida International University, Ball State University, University of Buffalo, University of Miami Ohio, St. Johns University, University of Pittsburgh, University of South Carolina at Spartanburg, University of New Orleans, and the University of Louisville. The distinction does not come from having great athletes it comes from having good coaches. Coach Dawes an Assistant at MCC for 22 years and the founder of the camp and Coach Kelly who is a product of the camp, a former MCC player and has been an assistant coach for 6 years. Both work extensively with the catchers along with their responsibilities with the pitchers. Through the years they have put together an extensive list of drills to develop catchers. The techniques, drills and philosophies that are worked on by the MCC catchers during practice are taught to the campers.

Since the beginning of the MCC catchers' camp many boys and girls that have attended have excelled at the position, some have received all league honors as well as participating on all-star teams. The camp has produced many of the All-County catchers for Monroe County League.

The camp is exclusively for catching, it is the only one in the Northeast and one of the two in the nation. The camp allows the time needed to focus on this position that is so important to the defense. Techniques of the position will be taught and refined with a multitude of drills for throwing mechanics, blocking, receiving, pitch calling, bunt coverage, covering home plate and becoming a team leader. There will be film study sessions on major league and college catchers. Every camper will receive a camp T-shirt and the opportunities to win awards.

Camp Staff and Bios:

• Pete Dawes - MCC Assistant Baseball Coach

Pete is the founder of the Camp and holds the MCC team record for fewest stolen bases upon (2) in a season. First team JUCO All American 1978 led team to the Div. I NJCAA College World Series in 1978, attended Florida International University and again led his team to the NCAA Div. II World Series, while being picked for the All-South District Team in 1980.

• Mike Kelly - MCC Assistant Baseball Coach

This is Mike's eighth year working the camp. As an MCC team member Mike hit .412 in 1997, was All Region III in 1997, and went on to play baseball at SUNY Brockport.

• Bob Hurlbutt

This is Bob's ninth year working the camp. He was a member of the MCC 1989 team that went undefeated through the region and went on to the Div. I JUCO World Series, hit .420 with 11 home runs and 54 RBI, was second team JUCO All American in 1989 and was drafted in 1989 by the Houston Astros.

• Dave Brust - MCC Assistant Baseball Coach

This is Dave's eighth year working the camp. He played for MCC in 1986-1987, hit .423 with 11 homeruns and 49 RBI while splitting time at third base and catching in 1987. Dave was third team JUCO All American in 1987 and attended Ball State University on scholarship. He was drafted by the Atlanta Braves, and also played for the famous Durham Bulls.

• Amanda Page

Four time 1st Monroe County All-Star Co-Player of the year in 2006 and 4th Team All-State from Batavia High School. Amanda attended last year's camp.
