MATH PLACEMENTS

Initial placements are based on **Accuplacer Test SCORES (not percentiles)**. The following placements were designed to give students at the lower end of each range approximately a 50% chance of earning a grade of “C” or better in the recommended course. **Placements may be revised** based on a review of the student’s previous transcripts, or based on pre-testing during the first week of a TRS or MTH class.
