# ***POLICE MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR COURSE***

*8:30 am – 4:30 pm*

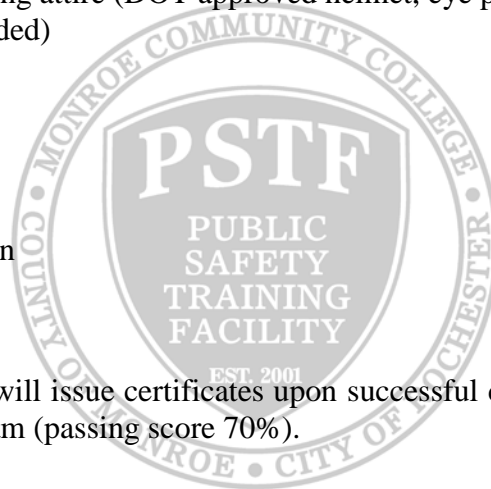
The Public Safety Training Center, in partnership with the Monroe County Sheriff's Office, will conduct the 80- hour ***Police Motorcycle Operator Course***. This course will be held on the above dates and time at the Public Safety Training Facility, room 107, 1190 Scottsville Rd., Rochester, New York 14624. Class size is limited to 12 students.

#### **Prerequisites for this skilled operator course are:**

- Full time law enforcement officer
- Possess a valid Class M (motorcycle) license
- Must supply their own motorcycle
- Provide and wear proper riding attire (DOT approved helmet, eye protection, full finger gloves, over the ankle boots, rain gear as needed)

#### **Topics of this course will include:**

- Maintenance
- Emergency Braking
- Evasive Maneuvers
- Curb and obstacle negotiation
- Traffic Stops
- Curve negotiation



The Public Safety Training Center will issue certificates upon successful completion of a riding practical exam (passing score 75%) and written exam (passing score 70%).

#### ***Lead Instructors:***

**Deputy Matthew MacKenzie** is a Police Motorcycle Operator Instructor certified through Northwestern University Center for Public Safety. Deputy MacKenzie is a 12 year veteran of law enforcement. Deputy MacKenzie began his career law enforcement career with the Fairfax County Police Va. Deputy MacKenzie has been a member of the Monroe County Sheriff's Office Motorcycle Unit for 7 years, and has attended basic motorcycle school through the Colonie NY police and Northwestern University. Deputy MacKenzie is certified General Topics Instructor, EVOC instructor, Radar / Lidar Instructor, and a field training officer for his department.

**Deputy Edward Cerone**, a 17 year veteran of the Monroe County Sheriff's Office, is a Police Motorcycle

Operator Instructor certified through the Maryland State Police. Deputy Cerone has been a member of the Monroe County Sheriff's Office Motorcycle Unit for 8 years, and has attended basic motorcycle school through the Colonie, NY Police and Northwestern University. Deputy Cerone is a certified General Topics Instructor, Breath Test Administrator Instructor, Field Training Officer, and as a NYS Paramedic.

Successful completion of this course will be worth 4 college credits from Monroe Community College.

**Tuition for this course is \$512.00 per person plus \$54.50 in student fees.** *A certificate of residency from out-of-Monroe county residents is required in order to avoid double tuition billing.* You will be billed at the completion of the course. It will not be necessary to send a check or voucher prior to class.
