It is easier to avoid receiving a ticket than it is dealing with it after you get one! Read the large A-Frame signs posted at each of the entrances and signs at each of the parking lots.*

### Important Reminders:

- All students who will be parking on the Brighton campus must purchase and display a parking permit. There is a limited number of meters available to students on the Arts/Res. Lane.
- Always resolve citations. The initial fine is cheaper than the additional late charges. The tickets won't go away. One way or another you will have to pay or you will get the "boot"
- Overnight Parking must be approved in advance (except during snow removal season when there is registering your vehicle NO overnight parking) by registering your vehicle with the Public Safety Dispatcher at 585.292.2911.
- If you need assistance with your vehicle (jump start, unlock, fuel ) notify the Public Safety Dispatcher by calling 585.292.2911 or use a Blue Light Emergency phones located on the exterior
- Always lock your vehicle and your valuables out of sight, better yet don't bring them to campus. If you see anything suspicious out in the parking immediately at 292.2911.
- You may request an escort to your vehicle from Public Safety.

# Ways to Avoid Parking Problems at MCC



The Monroe County Parking Program at MCC authorizes parking on the Brighton Campus by permit or at meters only and is enforced 24/7 all year. Anytime your vehicle is parked in a non metered space without a valid parking permit displayed it is subject to ticketing.

Know the Traffic and Parking Regulations and where your permit authorizes you to park. Once you are a registered student you are prohibited from parking in the Monroe/Visitor Meter parking loop for ANY REASON. Your vehicle will be ticketed and may be towed.

**Don't Take the chance.** Settle all citations immediately. The initial fine is cheaper than late fees and getting the "boot".

## Legal Parking Spaces and Overflow

Parking spaces are identified by lines on both sides of the vehicle. Just because it looks like a space (in between 2 cars), doesn't mean it is. If it is not lined, it is not a space! Even if you see someone pulling out or other cars parked in the same manner, check to make sure that it is in fact a space. If you chose to park in a place that is not a space your vehicle will be ticketed!

Give yourself ample time to find a parking space—be aware of the peak class times 9 AM—1 PM. Finding a parking space near where your class is, may be rare. Your permit allows you an opportunity to park within specified areas. It does not guarantee the holder a parking space. Observe the signs that show whether a lot is full or not. Don't bother wasting your time cruising the lots for a space on the south end of campus unless it is before 9 AM. That side of campus is full by then. Lot M –1 and D are usually the last lots to fill up.

Overflow is at the Sports Center at MCC and is only opened when the entire campus is full and you are directed by an Officer to park there.

Officers are on patrol to assist you. If you can't find one call us at 292-2700.

## *Know the deadline!*

Display your valid permit as instructed on the reverse of the permit by the deadline that is published for that semester. Laying it on your dash is not valid; it must be affixed to the window to be valid. Regardless of the reason, if you do not have the permit displayed by the deadline your vehicle is subject to ticketing and you will be responsible for all citations.

Don't share your permit. The registered owner of the permit is responsible for ALL parking violations. If you need a replacement permit, be sure to remove your old permit so that a new one can be issued at NO CHARGE. If you are driving a different car for a day, park at a student meter (Arts/Res. Lane) until you get a temporary permit. Know where your permit authorizes you to park. You are never authorized to park in the Monroe/Visitor Loop, or in Employee or Reserved Areas. Refer to the Traffic and Parking Regulations.
