

Class of 2006 Profile

Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,574

- 1,703 (66%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 710 (28%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 161 (6%) were Certificate Program graduates

Survey responses were received from 1,239 alumni (a 48% response rate)

Of the Survey Respondents:

- 96% are continuing their education and/or are employed.
- 53% transferred to 135 different colleges.
- 68% of Transfer Program graduates are continuing their education, 30% of whom transferred to a SUNY institution.
- 44% were hired by 637 different employers.
- 64% of Career and Certificate program graduates are employed full-time, 58% of whom are employed locally.

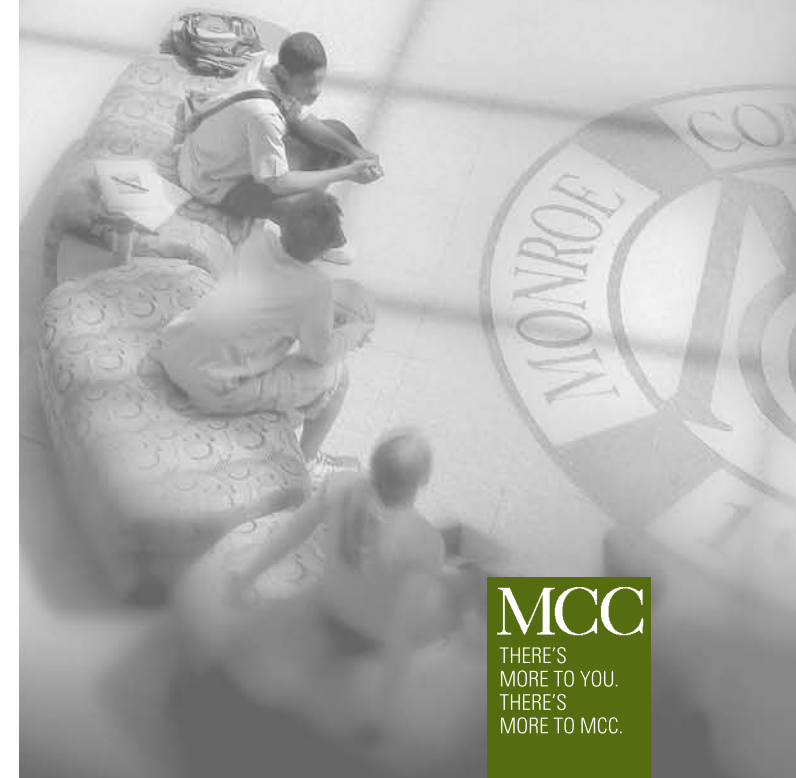
