

# Class of 2007 Profile

**Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,635**

- 1,716 (65%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 718 (27%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 201 (8%) were Certificate Program graduates

Survey responses were received from 1,883 alumni (a 72% response rate)

## Of the Survey Respondents:

- 1,811 (96%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- 67% of Career and Certificate Program graduates are employed full-time, 92% of whom are employed locally.
- Graduates were hired by 829 different employers
- 75% of Transfer Program graduates are continuing their education, 42% of whom transferred to a SUNY institution.
- Graduates transferred to 138 different colleges
