

# Class of 2008 Profile

**Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,511**

- 1,600 (64%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 722 (29%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 189 (8%) were Certificate Program graduates

Survey responses were received from 1,739 alumni (a 69.3% response rate)

## Of the Survey Respondents:

- 1,683 (97%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- 67% of Career and Certificate Program graduates are employed full-time, 93% of whom are employed locally
- Graduates were hired by 662 different employers
- 75% of Transfer Program graduates are continuing their education, 57% of whom transferred to a SUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 130 different colleges
