Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,634

- 1,770 (67%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 701 (27%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 163 (6%) were Certificate Program graduates

Survey responses were received from 1,718 alumni (a 65.2% response rate)

Of the Survey Respondents:

- 1,650 (96%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- 64% of Career and Certificate Program graduates are employed full-time, 90% of whom are employed locally
- Graduates were hired by 660 different employers
- 76% of Transfer Program graduates are continuing their education, 59% of whom transferred to a SUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 139 different colleges
