

# Class of 2010 Profile

**Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,554**

- 1,727 (68%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 647 (25%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 180 (7%) were Certificate Program graduates

Survey responses were received from 1,692 alumni (a 66.2% response rate)

## Of the Survey Respondents:

- 1,602 (95%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- 62% of Career and Certificate Program graduates are employed full-time, 91% of whom are employed locally
- Graduates were hired by 637 different employers
- 76% of Transfer Program graduates are continuing their education, 43% of whom transferred to a SUNY or CUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 132 different colleges
