Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,348

- 1,482 (63%) — Transfer Program graduates
- 697 (30%) — Career Program graduates
- 169 (7%) — Certificate Program graduates

Survey response rate = 1,462

Highlights: Based on survey response

- 96% of the graduates are either employed or continuing their education (85% in a full-time capacity).
- 84% of career and certificate program graduates employed full-time are in jobs related to their field of study. Of these students 93% found employment locally.
- 86% of graduates are continuing their education at public or private four-year colleges; 51% are attending SUNY units.
- Graduates transferred to 94 different colleges and universities.

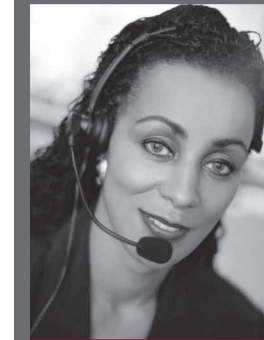
