

# Class of 2004 Profile

**Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,568**

- 1,674 (65%) — Transfer Program graduates
- 727 (28%) — Career Program graduates
- 167 (7%) — Certificate Program graduates

Survey response rate = 71% (1,818 respondents)

**Highlights:** Based on survey response

- 96% of the graduates are either employed or continuing their education (86% in a full-time capacity).
- 85% of career and certificate program graduates employed full-time are in jobs related to their field of study. Of these students 85% found employment locally.
- 57% of graduates are continuing their education at public or private four-year colleges; 49% are attending SUNY units.
- Graduates transferred to 136 different colleges and universities.

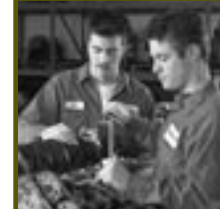
