

Class of 2005 Profile

Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,680

- 1,721 (64%) — Transfer Program graduates
- 763 (29%) — Career Program graduates
- 196 (7%) — Certificate Program graduates

Survey response rate = 75% (2,012 respondents)

Highlights: Based on survey response

- 96% of the graduates are either employed or continuing their education (86% in a full-time capacity).
- 84% of career and certificate program graduates employed full-time are in jobs related to their field of study. Of these students 89% found employment locally.
- 60% of graduates are continuing their education at public or private four-year colleges; 56% are attending SUNY units.
- Graduates transferred to 143 different colleges and universities.

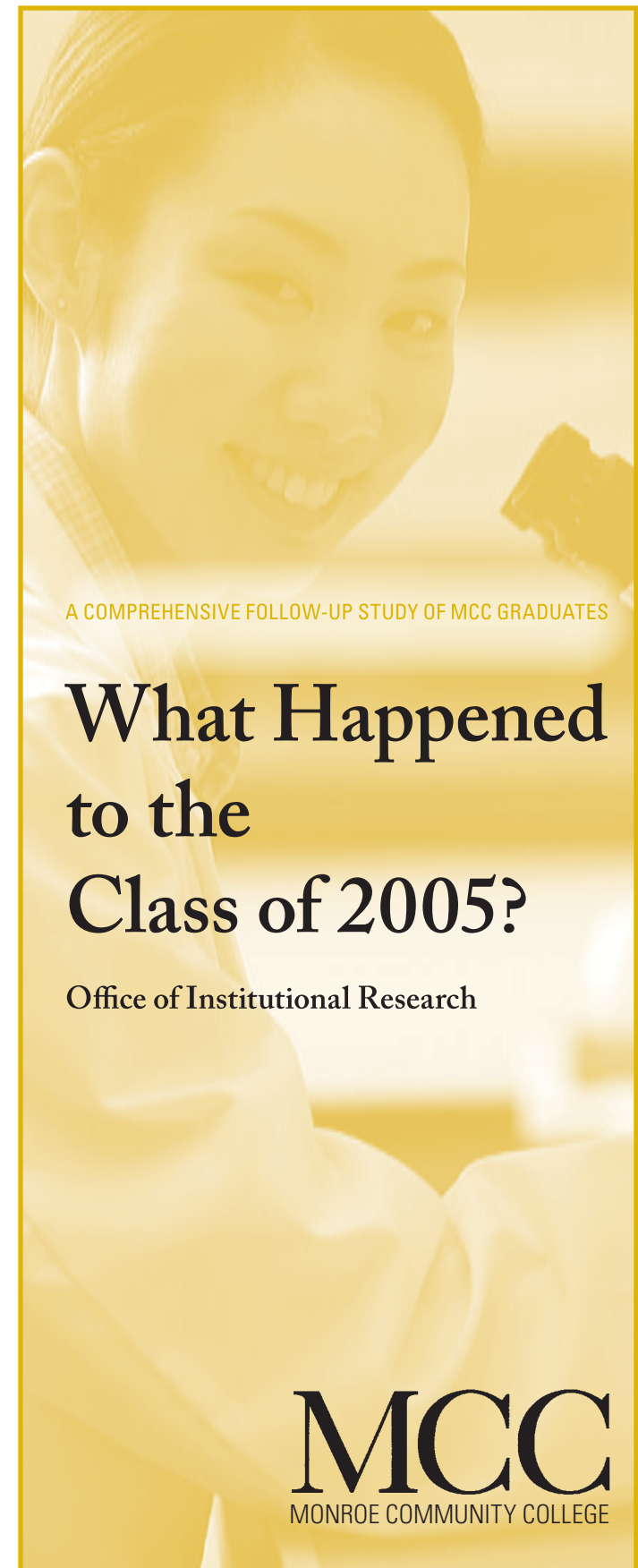
