1. SUNY Brockport	<ul> <li>The equivalent of one year of the same language or completion at the MCC 102 level with a grade of C, or</li> <li>Three credits of Level 2 (102) foreign language if student completed 3 years of the foreign language in high school and received an 85 or higher on the Regents exam.</li> <li><u>CLEP</u> test and <u>AP</u> scores - May be used to determine proficiency in a foreign language</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is acceptable</li> <li>MCC's <u>SPA 122 and 123</u> are acceptable</li> </ul>
2. SUNY Buffalo State	<ul> <li>Students must demonstrate proficiency in a single foreign language equivalent to the successful completion of one year of college-level work (102-level proficiency or equivalent).</li> <li>Successful completion of one language through the second year in high school satisfies the requirement IF the student passes the high school Regents exam.</li> <li><u>CLEP Test</u> - Proficiency in foreign language may be achieved by completing 6 credits on the CLEP test.</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is acceptable.</li> <li>MCC's <u>SPA 122 and 123</u> are acceptable</li> </ul>
3. SUNY Cortland	<ul> <li>Successfully complete the second semester (102) of a college level foreign language sequence, or</li> <li>Confirm proficiency equivalent to successful completion of the second semester (102) of a college level foreign language sequence through a testing program approved by the SUNY Cortland International Communications and Culture Department</li> <li><u>American Sign Language (ASL)</u> is acceptable for teacher education students <u>ONLY</u> for the following EDUCATION programs:         <ul> <li>Childhood Education,</li> <li>Early Childhood Education,</li> <li>Inclusive Special Education</li> <li>Adolescence Education: Mathematics concentration (7-12)</li> <li>Adolescence Education</li> <li>Physical Education</li> </ul> </li> <li>MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123 are acceptable for students pursuing a B.S. degree</li> <li><u>PHYSICAL EDUCATION majors</u> do not need Foreign Language through the 102 level – they need either 1 foreign language or 1 Sign Language course or having earned an 85 on their High School foreign language Regents exam.</li> </ul>
4. SUNY	<ul> <li>Must complete 6 credits in the same college level foreign language, or</li> <li>Complete 3 years of high school foreign language with an 85% or higher on the regents exam.</li> <li>American Sign Language (ASL) is acceptable</li> </ul>

Fredonia	MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123 are acceptable
5. SUNY Geneseo	<ul> <li>All initial teacher certification programs require the satisfactory completion of the foreign language requirement through the third semester (<u>equivalent to MCC's 103 level</u>) of a foreign language. The foreign language requirement for certification can be satisfied in any one of the following ways:</li> <li>A grade of (C-) or better in a foreign language course at the Geneseo 201 level (MCC's 103 level) or a score on the foreign language placement test that places the student at this level, or</li> <li>4 units of a foreign language in high school (completion of foreign language sequence through Level IV, one year beyond regents exam) and a grade of 85% or better in the New York State Regents Exam, or</li> <li><u>AP exam</u> - A score of 4 or better on the advanced placement examination in a foreign language, or</li> <li>Equivalent coursework with a minimum grade of C- transferred from another college.</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> is acceptable – NOTE: SUNY Geneseo does not offer ASL, so students should take MCC's ASL 103 before they transfer.</li> <li><u>MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123</u> are acceptable, but the student also needs to take SPA 103.</li> </ul>
6. SUNY Oswego	<ul> <li>Completion of a 102-level foreign language course (or its equivalent) in college.         <ul> <li>Students must demonstrate basic competency in a language by successfully completing either a 101-level college foreign language course or three years of foreign language study in high school prior to registering for a 102-level college course in the same foreign language, or</li> <li>Successful high school study of a foreign language through Regents Level 4, or</li> <li>Successful high school study of two foreign languages (through Regents Level 2 in each), or</li> <li>The requirement may be satisfied by an equivalent proficiency in a Native American language, as demonstrated by comparable high school study (i.e. four years) or by an interview with a faculty member competent in the language in question.</li> <li>Non-native-English-speaking international students who have passed the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam upon acceptance to the College are exempted from this requirement.</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is acceptable</li> <li>MCC's <u>SPA 122 and SPA 123</u> are acceptable</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
7. Daemen College (in Buffalo)	<ul> <li>Regardless of demonstrated proficiency, all programs leading to teacher certification require completion of a minimum of 6 credit hours in one foreign language.</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is <u>NOT ACCEPTABLE</u> for transfer to Daemen College</li> <li><u>MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123</u> are <u>NOT ACCEPTABLE</u> for transfer to Daemen College</li> </ul>
8. Keuka College	<ul> <li>3 credits of college level Foreign Language required, or</li> <li>2 years of high school foreign language.</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is acceptable</li> <li>MCC's <u>SPA 122 and 123</u> are acceptable</li> </ul>
9. Nazareth College	<ul> <li>6 credits of the same college level foreign language is required for teacher education programs <u>EXCEPTION:</u> Students in the Adolescence Ed program with Business/Marketing as a concentration</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is <u>NOT ACCEPTABLE</u> for transfer to Nazareth College <ul> <li>EXCEPTION: Music Education, Art Education and Business Education</li> </ul> </li> <li><u>MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123</u> are <u>NOT ACCEPTABLE</u> for transfer to Nazareth College If the student already took SPA 122, register for SPA 102 &amp; NAZ will accept the SPA 122</li> </ul>

10. Niagara University	<ul> <li>3 credits of college level Foreign Language required, additional credits could apply to the liberal arts concentration OR as a free elective</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is acceptable</li> <li><u>MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123</u> are acceptable</li> </ul>
11. Roberts Wesleyan College	<ul> <li>Proficiency in a foreign language may be shown by the following: <u>Early Childhood, Childhood and Adolescence Education Majors:</u></li> <li>Completing three years of the same language in high school with grades of C or better. Grades 7 &amp; 8 each count as <sup>1/2</sup> year if the same language is continued at a higher level.</li> <li>If no language was taken in high school, passing two sequential semesters of the same language at Roberts Wesleyan College.</li> <li>Continuing at the appropriate level a language begun in high school until successful completion of the 102 level.</li> <li>Successful performance on the final examination for the 102 level course in the language of choice. No course credit is given for passing the exam; it simply establishes a proficiency level.</li> <li><u>CLEP</u> - Successful performance on the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) examination to the six-credit level for languages not offered in the CLEP.</li> <li><u>Art Education &amp; Music Education:</u></li> <li>A minimum of 2 years of a foreign language with grades of C or better taken in high school or <u>one semester</u> at the appropriate level in college. <u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is acceptable for education majors <ul> <li><u>Exceptions: ASL does not fulfill the foreign language requirement for Music Education-Vocal</u></li> <li><u>MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123</u> are acceptable</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
12. St. John Fisher College	<ul> <li>Six credits of the same college level Foreign Language</li> <li><u>American Sign Language</u> (ASL) is acceptable for education majors         <ul> <li><u>EXCEPTION</u>: Any student planning to transfer to SJFC in the Adolescence B.A. degree program with a concentration in English, History, or Math MUST choose a foreign language other than ASL.</li> </ul> </li> <li><u>MCC's SPA 122 and SPA 123</u> are acceptable</li> </ul>

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1. Do NOT take conversation courses.

2. MCC Education Transfer Associate Degrees require <u>6 credits</u> of the <u>same foreign language</u>. Depending on the transfer college, the student may not need to complete this requirement. Please contact the Department of Education (phone: 585-262-1460) for course substitution/waiver information.
