5 **Ask questions BEFORE they turn into problems!** Not sure if you're understanding a concept in class? Ask your instructor for help! Have a test coming up, and you need help preparing? Meet with one of MCC's tutors! *(Brighton Campus: Building 11, RM 261A, Downtown Campus: 4th Floor Learning Commons)*

6 **Plan ahead!** Pay attention to advisement and registration dates so you can sign up for next semester's classes. If you still haven't picked a major, MCC has TONS of options!

7 **Explore all the options with RTS!** MCC has partnered with RTS to make traveling to campus easier and more affordable for students.

8 **Be ready to learn and work with a bunch of different people.** In college, you're learning both in and out of the classroom. Getting to know people with different backgrounds and experiences is part of the college experience!

9 **Learn time management skills and how to prioritize tasks.** Writing down due dates in a planner, color coding each course folder, and writing to-do lists are all examples of ways to stay organized of your coursework.

INTRODUCING TRIBUNE POINTS

Now there's one more reason to get involved...

WHAT ARE TRIBUNE POINTS?

Tribune Points is a First Year Experience reward program. Each event attended earns one tribune point.

WHO CAN EARN TRIBUNE POINTS?

All registered MCC students are eligible to participate in Tribune Points. You must have a valid MCC Student ID to participate.

HOW DO I EARN TRIBUNE POINTS?

Swipe your MCC ID while attending First Year Experience. These events are always free and open to all students to attend.

HOW MANY TRIBUNE POINTS ARE EVENTS WORTH?

Students will earn 1 Tribune Point for each FYE event they attend.
2 FYE Events = FYE Bronze Badge and chance to win a \$200 WalMart Gift Card!
4 FYE Events = FYE Silver Badge and chance to win a \$400 WalMart Gift Card!
6 FYE Events = FYE Gold Badge and chance to win a \$600 WalMart Gift Card!

HOW MANY TRIBUNE POINTS DO I HAVE?

Students will be able look up how many FYE programs they have attended via blackboard. Please contact First Year Experience for more information.

HOW DO I EARN TRIBUNE POINT REWARDS?

Students that earn Bronze, Silver or Gold FYE Badges are entered into a drawing for prizes.
