

Mathematics Placement Guidelines Based on Recent Regents Exam Scores
(effective October 2011, beginning with the Spring 2012 semester)

Students who have taken the Regents Geometry and / or Algebra Trigonometry exams within the last three years may be placed according to the following table. (Students meeting the qualifications in the table below are not required to take the Accuplacer test. However, if a student wishes to challenge this placement, the student may take the Accuplacer test.)

Regents Exam Score in last 3 years		MCC Placement Level
Geometry	Alg. 2-Trig or MathB	
85 or above	70 – 74	Level 6
X	75 – 82	Level 8
X	83 or up	Level 9

*There is no Regents Exam for Precalculus Mathematics. The current prerequisite for MTH 210 based on high school record would be Precalculus with a grade of 83 or higher in the last three years. An AP Calculus exam score of 3 or higher in the last three years would also be acceptable as level 10 placement, since we would grant credit for MTH 210 based on that score and would want students to be able to repeat Calculus if they chose to do so.
