

Transferring the *MCC Health Studies Degree* into Other Nursing Programs

If you would like to transfer to a BS Nursing program at another school, the information below gives you the specific courses for various schools. SUNY Brockport

Required: CHE 124

Must choose BIO 142 & 143, PSY 212, MTH 160, SOC 101, BIO 217 (Choose SUNY Gen Ed electives)

Nazareth

Required: CHE 124, 145 or 151

Must choose BIO 142 & 143, PSY 212, MTH 160

Roberts

Required: CHE 124 & BIO 155 (May be able to take equivalent of BIO 155 at Roberts – check with school)

Must choose BIO 142 & 143, PSY 212, BIO 217

St. John Fisher

Required: CHE 124 or 151

Choose BIO 142 & 143, MTH 160, PSY 212

Additional recommended electives include HED 115 and PHL 103

Other Colleges: Check with the individual institution for entrance requirements.

Third Semester

___ **BIO 135** Anatomy and Physiology II or 143 Physiology – 3-4 credits (choose 143 if going into healthcare or medical field)

___ **HED 208** Chronic and Communicable Disease (prereq HED 108, 110, or 130) **OR**

HED 210 Complementary, Alternative and Integrative Approaches to Health and Wellness – 3 credits

___ **PSY 201/202/212** Developmental Psychology for the Child, Adolescent, or Lifespan – 3 credits (Prereq PSY 101)
(Pre-Nursing students must take 212) (SUNY GEN ED)

___ **BIO 202** Microbiology – 4 credits (Prereq BIO 134 or BIO143)

Important Information Regarding Prerequisites: Depending on placement and testing scores, students may be required to take additional math, reading, and/or science courses prior to taking the subsequent coursework within the program. This may extend the length of time to graduation.
