




- **New York State, with SUNY as the lead, designated one of 15 Jobs for the Future (JFF) Student Success Centers**

Math Pathways Spring Forum in Saratoga on June 8-10

- Almost 200 people attended 100 new faculty, over 40 returning faculty, 15 administrators and advisors

OUR JOURNEY

- Pathways 2014 National Forum (Boston)
- Fall 2015 decided to adopt Quantway and targeted Liberal Arts Students
- Prior to our first course offerings in Spring 2017 we had seven faculty members trained and two academic advisors attend a forum
- Fall 2015 in-class observations
- Spring 2016 New Course Proposals submitted
- Spring 2016 Faculty Facilitator met with advisors and gave a presentation on placement for Quantway
- June 2016 QW Brochures were dropped off at Academic Advising Office and Admissions Office
- Quantway Core and Quantway College was first offered in Spring 2017
- Spring 2017 trained three tutors in-house
- Executive Vice President and Chief Academic Officer and Associate Vice President and Dean of Liberal Arts attended June 2017 Forum

LESSONS LEARNED

- It is never too early to reach out to academic advising
- Maintain open lines of communications with academic advisors
- Have tutors trained before courses are offered
- Have support from the Math Lab
- Have the Dean or Chair of each targeted student population attend a forum early on in the adoption process


