

EMERGENCY FOOD DISTRIBUTIONS

WHEN:

FEBRUARY 18 - 22

Due to the government shutdown, there is a large gap between the issuance of SNAP dollars, and families who rely on SNAP benefits are struggling to stretch their food budget. To respond to this need, Foodlink will be hosting emergency food distributions in the City of Rochester and surrounding counties.

- *First-come, first-served basis*
- Food will be distributed to approximately 250 households per location
- Food is expected to last a minimum of 3 days for a household of 4
- No income requirements; distributions intended for SNAP recipients
- No I.D. required, but name, address, and household size will be recorded
- Must be 18 or older to accept food
- No residency requirements
- Rain or shine
