Stephen Wise is a seasoned criminal justice administrator that has been successful in a variety of professional roles throughout his 30 year career. He is currently director of Campus Safety at SUNY Genesee Community College.

Wise holds a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice Administration from Keuka College, Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from The SUNY College at Brockport and he attended Monroe Community College. He is also a graduate of the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia.
