DEVELOPMENT

ALUMNI

- Under the leadership of **Mike Krupnicki '85**, engaged alumni, students, staff, retirees and friends in the combined in-person and virtual 5K Walk/Run for Scholarships raising \$20,755 in support of student scholarships. The event attracted 335 participants, 156 donors and 30 volunteers. Awarded \$5,000 in scholarships during the awards ceremony held via Facebook Live. Acknowledged event sponsor **Tucker Printers.** Due to COVID-19, the tailgate party was not held following the walk/run.
- Identified and cultivated alumni prospects on an ongoing basis.

ANNUAL FUND

- In partnership with **Athletics Department**, concluded fall crowd fundraiser for the women's soccer team raising \$2,768.
- Recognized President's Circle of Honor and President's Circle donors in the 2020-2021 Impact Report.
 The President's Circle Reception was not held due to circumstances revolving around the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Launched the 2021-2022 campaign theme "Rising Together."
- Established a 2021-2022 Annual Fund campaign goal of \$724,953.
- Finalized concept and delivered the leadership direct mail piece to 1,226 donors.
- Developed and delivered the end-of-year direct mail solicitation authored by **Gretchen Wood** and featuring MCC scholarship recipient **Jaylon Taylor** to 4,660 prospective donors.
- Raised a record-breaking \$27,186 during our ROC the Day for MCC event held on November 30. Special
 thanks to co-chairs Colby Feane and Kevin Williams for leading MCC's campaign this year.
- Continued to promote the matching challenge opportunities available to donors, faculty and staff with a
 gift to the Annual Fund or the Dreamkeepers Emergency Student Aid Program. Gifts could be matched up
 to three times thanks to the generosity of John DiMarco II, Sergio Esteban, Howard Konar and Dutch
 Summers.
- Secured \$280,585 in gifts and pledges to date representing 39 percent of goal.
- Achieved 27 percent board giving with gifts and pledges totaling \$151,741.

Major Gifts

- With advocacy from Jeremy Wolk, obtained a grant of \$1.25 million from the Louis S. and Molly B. Wolk
 Foundation to build new laboratory space for health care training programs at MCC's Downtown
 Campus.
- Under the leadership of Lori Van Dusen, promoted the New York State Charitable Tax Credit program to MCC Foundation Directors, Foundation Council, and leadership donors and prospects. The effort resulted in gifts from 30 donors totaling \$642000.

- Renewed the Greater Rochester Health Foundation's support of the Healthy Hero Summer Camp with a pledge of \$469,710.
- With the leadership of Maureen Wolfe, secured a grant of \$423,710 from ESL Charitable Foundation to support accelerated workforce development training programs over the next three years. In addition to providing technical training for in-demand career paths, the grant invests in supports for student success, including tuition assistance, mentoring, and teaching soft skills.
- Advocacy from Todd Baxter '10 and Ken Hines resulted in a \$100,000 grant from the Bank of America Charitable Foundation to expand MCC's Certified Nursing Assistant training program.
- Inspired by the work of **STAR Power** and with assistance from **Lori Van Dusen**, **Dr. Ian Wilson** pledged \$40,000 to create the Sadie L. Wilson Scholarship. It honors his mother and will support single student parents at MCC.
- Hosted a series of roundtable meetings to introduce MCC's sixth president Dr. DeAnna R. Burt-Nanna to
 key donors and constituents. The meetings were hosted in partnership with Foundation Directors and
 Council members including Dan Burns, Essie Calhoun-McDavid, John DiMarco II, Emerson Fullwood,
 Rich Warshof '68, Lori Van Dusen, and Maureen Wolfe, and engaged more than 60 guests.
