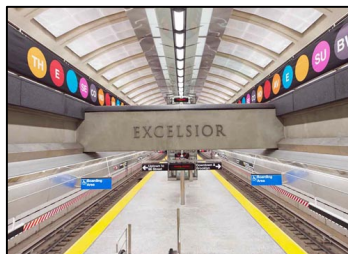
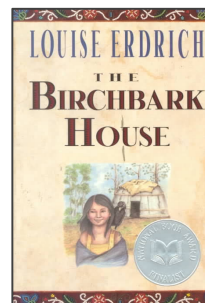
# ROOM LOCATIONS
