Development

Alumni

Annual Fund

- Delivered the spring renewal direct mail solicitation authored by MCC student **Addie Washington '23** to 3,400 lapsed donors, non-donors, faculty and staff, raising \$4,545 to date. Major Gifts

- Renewed **ThorLabs'** investment in the optical systems technology program with a three-year grant of \$208,460. Their investment helps provide administrative support for the program.
- Secured a \$133,000 grant from the **Max and Marian Farash Charitable Foundation** for the Diversifying the New Teacher Pipeline pilot project. The goal of the pilot is to develop and launch a mentoring program between MCC's teacher education students and early career educators from area school districts, with a special focus on the Rochester City School District.
