## DEVELOPMENT

### ALUMNI

- Began planning the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual 5K Walk/Run for Scholarships which will take place during Alumni Week and Homecoming 2021. The virtual walk/run is scheduled for the weekend of October 2 and 3.
