Timeline

- Late May/early June: search committee will be established Late August/early September:
 - Advertise position
 - Search Committee will meet with consultant and our SUNY liaison for the search to establish evaluation criteria
- Early October: Search committee will meet to select candidates to interview via Zoom
- Late October: Zoom interviews
- Mid-November: finalists come to campus (3-5 candidates)
- Spring 2021: New MCC President begins!

Consultant

• The Pauly Group was approved by the Board of Trustees at their March 2020 meeting. They are experts with community and technical college academic searches and have worked with other SUNY schools.

• The consultant will advertise/market the search, help solidify the search timeline, vet candidates-including listed and unlisted reference checks.

SUNY Guidelines

- We will have a SUNY liaison that will be a part of the process, including all search committee meetings. The liaison will not be a voting member of the search committee but keeps communication open between SUNY and MCC.
- There are SUNY guidelines for searches which we must adhere to and our timeline will be impacted by the steps that need to be taken for the final approval.

External Stakeholders

- Clayton Jones is soliciting feedback from the greater Rochester community.
- There will be external stakeholders on the search committee which may include County representatives, City representatives, MCC alumni, and members of the MCC Foundation.


