Ebony Caldwell has been employed at Monroe Community College since 2013 as “Project Director, Title III: Building a Culture of Engagement and Success.” She stated in her resume that her major accomplishment in this position was “Promoting a positive view on the purpose and practice of how data is viewed and collected.” Since 2013, she has also been employed at MCC in the role of “Affirmative Action Coordinator, Academic services Division at Monroe Community College”, which she acknowledges her major accomplishment was, “Conducting critical hiring conversations to align practice, policies, and procedures”.
