COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A unique study of Japanese myths and legends of the indigenous Shinto tradition and of Japanese Buddhism, which was reshaped from the Buddhism of India to fit the needs of the Japanese culture. The tour will include visits to several Shinto shrines and to Kamakura to view the Great Image of the Buddha. Other places on the itinerary will include Tokyo, cruise on Lake Hacone, Kyoto, Hiroshima, Osaka, and more locations, where students will experience eleven centuries of history and cutting edge of modernity. There will be on-location lectures, discussions, and journal writing recording content and experiential learning.
