After a long and contentious presidential campaign, more than 10,000 people spontaneously visited Susan B. Anthony's grave in Rochester, New York to pay tribute to America's most famous suffragist and place their "I Voted Today" stickers upon her headstone as an expression of their pride and gratitude.
